


Knob Lock with Fingerprint






Installation Guide



1. Check The Door's Dimension


- (1) Measure to confirm the thickness of the door is between 1-3/8" and 2-1/8" (35~54mm).
- (2) Measure to confirm the diameter of the hole in the door is 2-1/8" (54mm).
- (3) Measure to confirm the backset (as shown below) is either 2-3/8" (60mm) or 2-3/4" (70mm).
- (4) Measure to confirm the diameter of the hole in the door edge is 1" (25mm).





2. Install Latch and Strike

- (1) Set the Latch backset to 60mm(2-3/8") or 70mm(2-3/4") to fit your door hole.
- (2) Insert the Latch into the door hole, and tighten Screw A to fix the Latch. Install Striker Box and Striker Plate also with Screw A into the door frame.




3. Install Exterior Knob & Interior Knob

- (1) Install Exterior Knob (the lock body with Spindle and two Stems) from outside of your door and make sure the Spindle and Stems go through the three holes of the Latch.
- (2) Insert Interior Knob by aligning the two stems with the screw holes, connect the wire by inserting the connector into the socket, and tighten Screw B.

4. Install Batteries

- (1) Loosen the the screw to remove the battery cover in the Interior Knob.
- (2) Install 4 AAA batteries and tighten the screw to fix the battery cover. PLEASE DO NOT USE LITHIUM BATTERIES OR RECHARGABLE BATTERIES.



② Choose the country where the lock is being used, enter your Email address to get verification code, set password, select permissions and press "Go to APP" to finish the registration.













3. Add a lock

① Keep your phone close to the lock, touch the fingerprint sensor of the lock, and press the "Add Device" on the screen.




② Continue and tap "ALLOW ONLY WHILE IN USE".










(3) Allow to turn on the Bluetooth to connect the lock.








4 Tap "Add" and "+" to finish adding the lock.























4. Lock or unlock via APP


- ① Click the lock icon " o unlock the door

①Select "Member Management" on the screen ② Tap "+" to add more members





















6. Check log information

② Press "Time", "Operate" or "User" to review the history of the lock's working














7. Settings

① Select "Settings" on the screen to turn on/off "Auto Lock" or set up the time delay










② Turn on/off the "Do-Not-Disturb" and set up the time period according to your preference.







① Select "Intelligent application" on the screen, choose the scenes you prefer to set up intelligent interactions.



















9. Device information setup

11. Add new device or create new scene


① Peress " ⁶" on the top right of the screen to add more devices or create more scenes








12. Create scenes

① Select "Scene" on the screen, and choose "Automation" or "Tap-to-Run" to create scenes










1 Select "Smart" on the screen, and set up the smart functions you prefer

① Select "Me" on the screen, and you can set your nickname, choose your third-party voice, set up your home information, check messages or check FAQ related to the APP Third-party Voice Services












15. Use camera to scan


① Press the icon " $\frac{1}{c-3}$ " on the top right corner of the screen to scan if needed



Operation Guide

(1) Key to unlock

Press the screw in the back of the Exterior Knob, and the fingerprint head cover will come out for you to easily pull and turn.

Pull out the fingerprint head cover, insert the key and turn the key 90° to unlock, then turn the Exterior Knob to open the door.



(2) Low power indication

After being unlocked by fingerprint or APP successfully, the fingerprint head flashes green and then flashes red, it is time to install new batteries.

(3) Restore factory settings

Use pin to press the small reset button in the Interior Knob for 5 seconds, the buzzer will beep once and the fingerprint head will flash green, and the lock has been reset to factory settings.
